**National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE)
2014 Executive Summary**

Purpose: During the spring 2014 semester, freshmen/first year and senior students across Mississippi State University (MSU) were asked to participate in the National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE). The survey findings annually provide comparative standards for determining how effectively MSU's colleges are contributing to student learning. The NSSE 2014 results can be used for the 2014-15 assessment cycle.

Methodology: Nearly 6,900 freshmen/first year and senior student combined populations were asked to complete the survey in which 1,397 students responded. This gave a response rate of 20.3%, an increase of 2.7% from the previous year; nationally the response rate was 32%, an increase of 2%. The survey was deployed electronically by email invitation on five separate occasions. The initial invitation was sent on February 12, 2014, with three reminders over the next few weeks, and with a final reminder on March 24, 2014. This gave the students approximately a five-week window of opportunity to participate in the survey.

The response summary of the MSU data indicated there were more seniors respondents than freshmen/first year students (859 and 538 respectively.) The majority of students who completed the survey were females for both senior and freshmen/first year students (54% and 64% respectively). The percentage of respondents by enrollment status was also higher for fulltime students as compared to part-time with 98% freshmen/first year students and 90% senior students indicating they were full-time students.

A redesigned survey instrument was used to collect data starting with NSSE 2013. Forty-seven questions have been grouped within ten *Engagement Indicators*. The indicators are organized within four *Engagement Themes* adapted from the former Benchmarks of Effective Educational Practice. Six additional questions entitled *High Impact Practices* are also included. These High Impact Practices' questions were the former Benchmarks of Effective Educational Practice within Enriching Educational Experiences (four questions), Active and Collaborative Learning (one question), and Student Faculty Interaction(one question).

In 2014, there were 622 U.S. institutions, including Mississippi State University, to participate in the National Survey of Student Engagement. Data tables include comparisons of MSU overall results to 621 other U.S. institutions.

Results are divided into the following four Engagement Themes and arranged by the appropriate Engagement Indicator, with High Impact Practices reported separately:

- Academic Challenge
 - Higher Order Learning
 - Reflective and Integrative Learning
 - Learning Strategies
 - Quantitative Reasoning

- Learning with Peers
 - Collaborative Learning
 - Discussions with Diverse Others

- Experiences with Faculty
 - Student-Faculty Interactions
 - Effective Teaching Practices

- Campus Environment
 - Quality of Interactions
 - Supportive Environment.

The results are provided into data summary tables including:

- A data summary table of comparison shows the 2014 frequency results for the forty-seven Engagement Indicator questions and the six High Impact Practices questions by college. For every question, **black bolded** results in each college indicates the highest percentage among the Likert scaled categories for both freshmen/first year and senior students. Additionally, a comparison of MSU and NSSE overall results are **maroon bolded** for every question with the highest percentage response.

- Summary tables with comparison results by the individual college for the survey years of 2013 and 2014. The MSU and NSSE overall results are also included.

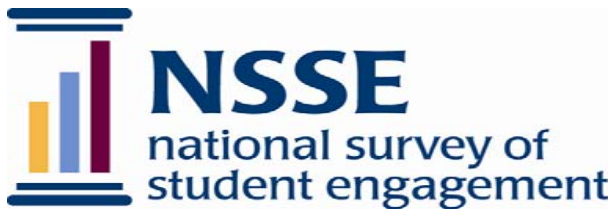
